



College Squash Association Annual Declaration of Adherence – Club Teams (2026-2027)

The undersigned certifies that the institution and the college squash program(s) identified below are and will remain in full compliance with CSA Bylaws, CSA Policies, and CSA sportsmanship expectations during the 2026-2027 season. This documentation can be found in full on the CSA website, www.csasquash.com and via communications with CSA staff.

For a club team to remain in *good standing* with CSA, teams and players must:

- Identify and maintain contact with a **team supervisor** who is not an undergraduate student. (Supervisors are encouraged to be a club sports advisor at the school or an independent non-student coach.)
- Build a **team leadership structure** (President/Captain; VP/Asst. Captain; etc.) which carries over from year to year.
- Maintain a **roster** of at least nine (9) active and **fully enrolled undergraduate players**.
- Devise and implement a **budget and fundraising plan** to support team's training & competition goals.
- Pay annual **CSA membership dues*** (\$1000 per team for 2026-2027), required for all club teams participating in the CSA league.
- **Pay championship entry fees**[^] (\$950 per team for 2026-2027), required only for teams entering the Club Team Championships.
- Play a competition schedule, which includes minimum match numbers by gender to qualify for the CSA National Collegiate Club Team Championships:
 - **Men:** at least 8 matches against at least 5 different opponents
 - **Women:** at least 6 matches against at least 4 different opponents

CSA club teams must also abide by the following terms of conduct, or risk penalties up to and possibly including removal from the CSA rankings and/or the team championship:

- Exhibit a high level of **sportsmanship, integrity, and fair play** always.
- **Wear ASTM-F3164 or ASTM-F803 approved eyewear/goggles** on court for **safety**, in line with [CSA and US Squash participation policies](#), during all CSA practice and competition.
- Follow through on **all competition commitments** made with opposing teams and host venues. Teams that back out of commitments on short notice (14 days or less) may be subject to penalties or fines.
- Design a competition roster and playing **ladder based on skill and merit**. The combination of US Squash player rating and challenge match results provides the best baseline to build a team ladder.
- Learn and practice the rules of the game and the expectations of referees and markers (visit [World Squash Officiating](#) for resources). All players must **pass the appropriate referee exam** on Club Locker before December 1 during the current season.
- Utilize CSA's [incident reporting](#) process to **report violations** of conduct or match commitments to the CSA Rules & Regulations Committee.

* - CSA annual membership dues include but are not limited to: US Squash membership for each rostered player, access to Club Locker for roster & scheduling purposes, inclusion in CSA Club rankings, access to database of other club team leaders, information about & connections to round robins and other playing opportunities, and secondary insurance for teams.

[^] - Championship entry fees cover: facility/court rental costs, tournament accreditation and insurance, tournament staff, tournament awards and gifts, and other necessary expenses to operate the event.
